#### Seasonal Lot Lease Renewals

Every year the form we send you to renew the Seasonal License of Occupation must be signed and returned BEFORE the season begins. Seasonal lot fees are due APRIL  $30^{\text{TH}}$ . All past due lot fees will have interest charged at 2% per month beginning May  $1^{\text{ST}}$ . In order to receive the early-pay discount we must receive your payment on or before February 28, 2018. We have pre-authorized debit available if you wish to use it for the 6 month payment plan. Credit cards will not be accepted for seasonal lot payments.

**NEW** – Please include your insurance company name & policy number for your trailer. Everyone MUST have liability insurance. If your insurance provider does not provide coverage, our local insurance company will provide this service regardless of your trailer age. Please contact the office for details.

Be sure to review the enclosed lease agreement and updated rules, check that your information is correct, sign the agreement form and return it to us with your payment. Thank you.

# Boats, Vehicles & Utility Trailers

Campsites are not to be used for boat, vehicle or utility trailer storage. We have other storage available. Please contact the office to make arrangements.

### **Golf Carts**

We require proof of insurance each year for your golf cart. Operators must have a valid driver's license and you must drive responsibly with riders seated at all times. Golf carts MUST have lights when driven in the dark.

### Garbage, Recycling & Yard Waste

The large red dumpsters are for regular household garbage ONLY. Bagged household garbage must be taken to the garbage area. Garbage cans within the park are for loose garbage only. WE DO NOT accept furniture, large electronic items, mattresses, carpets or construction materials. These items must be brought to the Varna Landfill Site. The metal area is for metal only. Anyone who drops off unauthorized items will be invoiced a minimum of \$75. Please DO NOT bag recyclables. Loose recyclables only.

Leaves must be bagged in paper yard waste bags. Please do not bag dirt. Grass clippings should be mulched. They may be dropped off at the yard waste section in the garbage area or left beside the street on your lot for pick up.

#### Off Season

Keep in mind that the hydro may not always be available during the off season. It is highly recommended that you empty your refrigerator and freezer prior to Oct 31<sup>st</sup>. Also during the off season, snow plowing may not be completed in all sections to the park.

### Euchre, Shuffleboard & Horseshoes

You are invited to play Euchre Tuesday and Thursday nights at 7pm. Cost is \$1 per night with prizes at the end of each night. There will be shuffleboard in the rec hall on Saturdays. Organized horseshoes are played on Saturdays throughout the season. Starting dates will be posted on the bulletin board and new players are always welcome!

### Family Bingo

Enjoy family Bingo every Saturday at 7pm and both Saturdays and Sundays on holiday weekends. Cost is \$1/card with great prizes to be won. Thanks to Ellen Frey for calling bingo!

#### Pool

The pool is for one immediate family per site. Immediate family is considered 2 adults and their unmarried children under the age of 21. Your guests (extended family, friends, grandchildren, etc.) are only required to pay a visitor fee to the park if they use the pool. Prior to entering the pool facilities they must register at the office and pay a nominal fee. The rates are:

Single: Daily - \$3, Weekly - \$10, Season - \$20 Family: Daily - \$10, Weekly - \$25, Season - \$50

IF YOUR GUEST(S) FAIL TO REGISTER AT THE OFFICE PRIOR TO USING THE POOL YOU WILL BE CHARGED \$10/PERSON/DAY

Please remember you are responsible for your guests and you must inform them of this policy.

For everyone's enjoyment, please obey ALL of the Pool Rules.

## **Campground Rules and Safety**

We again stress that the speed limit within the camp is 10km/h and you MUST obey stop signs. Our streets are also walkways and bike paths so always watch for others to ensure everyone's safety!

Please obey the One-Way street signs implemented within the park.

For your safety please use smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.

Please respect all other campers and do not cut through their lots. Inform your children of this rule as well.

Fireworks are NOT allowed within the camp.

DO NOT dispose of any types of sanitary pads in your toilets as it causes problems for our sewage pumps.

ALL site alterations MUST be approved by management. ABSOLUTELY NO digging holes.

No campfires after midnight.
